Undercover Support & Tactical Movement

Date: August 31, 2010 to September 2, 2010

Location: Given Upon Registration 

These classes will instruct on **Undercover Support involving Vehicle Assaults/Rescues** (1 Day Course) as well as a **Tactical Movement** course (1 ½ Day Course) involving officer rescue from both known and unknown locations within a structure. On the morning of the **Tactical Movement** course **William “Billy” Queen**, retired ATF agent, will make a presentation regarding his successful undercover infiltration of the Mongols Outlaw MC organization. These courses will run from Tuesday 8/31/10 thru 9/2/10.

Undercover support/vehicle - Course Description: Due to the number of undercover enforcement operations, many which occur in vehicles, LAW ENFORCEMENT needs to be prepared prior to an incident. We need to plan for such operations. All covering team members must be on the same “page” to react to either a vehicle assault and/or extraction-rescue situation. This training will enhance all prior tactical skills. The course will include planning issues involving this type of enforcement operation; the understanding and application of vehicle assault philosophies, vehicle assault principles, vehicle assault options and vehicle assault techniques. The course will result in all LEO’s participating in such an op trained on the same page regarding vehicle assaults as well as a vehicle rescue. The course will further provide tactical options for the mission changing from a basic cover team to a rescue/hostage type scenario and the fact that prior planning and training is imperative. The course will also include a suggested Officer Taken Hostage SOP. The course will commence with the classroom portion providing options for consideration and will then expand to practical application scenarios using Simunitions with role players (All students will have the opportunity to serve as a “suspect” during this force on force training). This is a one day course.

The course will *commence promptly at 0800* hours.

Tactical movement – Course Description: The tactical movement course will **further include** response to an Active Shooter scenario when the shooting has stopped and law enforcement has no intelligence on the whereabouts of the shooter(s). This segment of the course will offer techniques utilizing the minimum of a three-person element to clear the structure in an attempt to locate the shooter(s). This tactical movement course will be a two-day course commencing with

the morning presentation of Mr. Queen on Day 1. The remainder of the course will concentrate on tactical movement skills in order for a response to an officer/UC/CI taken hostage from both known and unknown locations within a structure. The course will also include a suggested Officer Taken Hostage SOP. The course will expand to practical application scenarios using Simunitions with role players.

The course will *commence promptly at 0800* hours each day.

Both of these courses will enhance law enforcement's ability to react to any tactical situation in a consistent and effective manner regarding undercover operations.

William "Billy" Queen presentation - **On the morning of the commencement of the tactical movement course Colt Law Enforcement Representative, William "Billy" Queen, retired ATF agent, will make a presentation regarding his successful undercover infiltration of the Mongols Outlaw MC organization.** (If one wishes to attend this portion of the training ONLY, there will be a separate fee of \$50.00 per attendee. If one signs up for the 2-day tactical movement course one is eligible to attend this presentation with no additional expense.) **Mr. Queen will be available to sign autographs as well as photographs.**

This training will occur at the different locations owned by the Absentee Shawnee Tribe. Notification of specific location will be given upon registration. The courses will run from Tuesday 8/31/10 thru 9/2/10. The cost of the Vehicle Assaults/Rescues course for each student is \$150.00. The cost of the tactical movement course including the presentation of Mr. Queen is \$300.00.

Students will be required to bring his/her duty belt as well as magazine pouch for both primary and secondary weapons, if applicable, as well as a flashlight (especially for the tactical movement course). It is recommended that students/LEO's, bring all the daily gear that is utilized on a daily basis. We highly recommend the warrior concept of TRAIN AS YOU FIGHT.

There will be a maximum number of **fifteen (15)** students for the Vehicle and tactical movement course (Maximum number for Billy Queen presentation depends on the classroom/hall for the presentation). All students will have the opportunity to serve as a suspect in a role player status. One of the beliefs of this training course is that LEO's become better operators after serving as a suspect/role player as threat angles will be viewed differently.
