# COLTEER .22 AUTOLOADER

From its true Western stock with classic straight lines, to its hooded Gold Bead front sight, this carbine combines old and new into a truly fine firearm, deserving of the famous Colt trademark. Its modern, autoloading action gives you the ultimate in a lightweight, easy-handlin' automatic for small game, varmints or just plain plinking. Has American walnut stock and fore-end. Barrel band on fore-end adds to its sporty look. Western style open rear sight adjustable for elevation and windage. Positive crossbolt safety. Weighs just 4½ pounds. Over-all length is 37°. Receiver is grooved for "lipoff" scope mounting. Tubular magazine holds 15.22 Long Rifles, Regular or High Speed. Here's a rifle you'll be proud to own. Made in Hartford. Conn. by Colt craftsmen.



#### **GENERAL OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Ammunition—Shoots all .22 long rifle ammunition, regular or hi-speed.

Safety—The Safety button (40) is located at the rear of the trigger guard (60). Slide Safety button from left to right to lock in "safe" position. Slide Safety button from right to left for "fire" position. When Safety button is in "fire" position, a band of red appears on the button, indicating the rifle is ready to fire.

#### **OPERATION**

To Load—Grasp magazine cap (30) and turn counterclockwise to release. Withdraw inner magazine tube from outer magazine tube until the loading port in outer magazine tube is open. Load from one to 15 cartridges in loading port, then push inner magazine tube back into position and lock.

Chamber may now be loaded by pulling cocking handle (39) to its extreme rear position and allowing it to go forward to closed position. After loading chamber, one more cartridge may be fed into the magazine for full fire load of 16 shots.

The gun may now be fired by pulling the trigger. Only one shot will fire with each pull of the trigger. Trigger must be released and pulled again for each additional shot.

ALWAYS keep Rifle on Safe until you are ready to fire it.

To Unload—Put Rifle on "Safe". Remove inner magazine tube and point muzzle down so that cartridges will slide out of magazine tube. Retract bolt to extract round in chamber. Check magazine throat before closing bolt to make sure there is not an additional cartridge in position to feed into chamber.

Replace inner magazine tube, then open and close the bolt several times while looking in the ejection port to make sure there are no cartridges in the magazine, and that the chamber is empty.

Always treat the rifle as if it were loaded, even when you are sure it is empty.

To Disassemble—Check rifle to make sure it is not loaded. Remove inner magazine tube (32). Remove forearm screw (16) and barrel band screw (35). Slide barrel band off forearm (15). Remove forearm. Drive out pin (61). Pull back cocking handle to extreme rear. With bolt in this position, trigger guard assembly can be removed by pulling out just forward of the trigger guard. Bolt can then be removed by pulling back slightly and the cocking handle and pulling bolt out thru bottom of receiver. Bolt spring assembly (39) may now be removed easily. To function properly, moving parts should be kept clean and free of powder residue and oiled very lightly.


We do not recommend disassembly beyond this point, except by qualified persons or gunsmiths.

Do not pull trigger while trigger guard is removed from fille as this puts undue strain on hammer and hammer stop pin. Reassemble rifle by reversing the above procedure.


Sighting—Your rifle has been sighted at the factory to hit point of aim at 50 yards. We recommend that you sight-in your rifle personally to compensate for a possible difference in sighting vision. The rear sight is adjustable for both windage and elevation.


## COMPAR 22 AUTOTODES




SIGHTS - Western style open rear sight adjustable for elevation and windage, hooded gold bead front sight. Receiver grooved for "tip-off" scope mounting.






Hooded Gold Bead Sight. Tubular Magazine holds 15 rounds.
